At 20 he became commander of a part of the army.

When Alexander became king he wanted to invade Greece. In 334 he defeated the enemy with a large group of soldiers. When Alexander came to Gordium he met Darius and killed him there.

Later on Alexander freed Egypt from Greek rule. He founded a city near the delta of the Indus River and called it Babylon.

Alexander wanted to go as far as eastern India but his soldiers wanted to fight the Egyptians. After returning to Persia Alexander and some of his men married Egyptian women because they were more attractive than others.

He was murdered at the age of 33 and his body was put into a pyramid in Egypt.
